- 4) The reason for hiring an engineer has either been your initial decision or this office has denied your application due to conditions not meeting the requirements of Rule 410 IAC 6-8.1.
An engineer may submit a design to this office but the design shall be reviewed by the health department and still must meet Rule 410 IAC 6-8.1 requirements.
- 5) Having a septic system designed by an engineer never constitutes an automatic approval for an on-site sewage disposal system (septic system).
- 6) In any business situation we strongly suggest you get as many references as possible before hiring an engineer.
- 7) Soil data must be performed by a soil scientist only and be supervised by the project engineer.
(Note: Site not always will be suitable)
- 8) Soil testing must be provided to include entire septic area in design.
- 9) If the location is not large enough to support the design, more than one area shall be evaluated with more soil data.
- 10) All soil evaluations and engineering is at the cost of the applicant and cost are set by the people or business you have hired.
