MEETING OF THE CLARK COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT BOARD WAS HELD IN DR. ADAIR'S OFFICE AT 7:30 P. M. July 14, 1961!

MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING READ AND APPROVED:

THE FREQUENCY OF TESTING WATER AT MOTELS AND RESTAURANTS, NOT SUPPLIED BY CITY WATER, WAS BROUGHT UP AND IT WAS UNANAMOUSLY AGREED BY THE BOARD, THAT THIS TEST BE DONE AT THREE MONTH PERIODS, RATHER THAN ONCE YEARLY, AS BEEN THE CUSTOM.

DR. ADAIR BROUGHT UP THE MATTER, SHOULD THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOLLOW-UP ON VETERANS, AFTER THEIR DISMISSAL FROM THE V. A. HOSPITALS? IT WAS UNANAMOUSLY VOTED THAT THIS COULD NOT BE DONE WITH OUR SMALL STAFF.

REGARDING THE VACATION FOR KATHLEEN WAGNER, IT WAS UNANAMOUSLY VOTED TO ALLOW MRS. WAGNER RETROACTIVE PAY DUE HER, IN LIEU OF VACATION PAY.

THE 1962 BUDGET WAS DISCUSSED TOTALING \$31,465.00 WHICH INCLUDED \$180.00 FOR A BOOKCASE, THE SALARIES AS STIPULATED THEREON (WHICH WERE THE SAME AMOUNTS AS WERE REQUESTED LAST YEAR.) REGARDING MILEAGE FOR THE EMPLOYEES THE BOARD UNANAMOUSLY DECIDED TO ALLOW A FLAT RATE OF \$40.00 MONTHLY FOR EACH INVESTIGATOR. AS THIS IS THE AMOUNT THE WELFARE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES.

THE QUESTION OF WHETHER OR NOT CONCESSION STANDS AT CARNIVALS BE SCREENED WAS BROUGHT UP. IT WAS THE DECISION OF THE BOARD, THAT THE SANITARIANS USE THEIR OWN JUDGEMENT IN THIS MATTER.

DR. ADAIR BROUGHT UP THE QUESTION REGARDING THE NEED OF AN ORDINANCE FOR GROCERIES AND RESTAURANTS, AND SAID THAT THE STATE WAS SENDING HIM SAMPLE FOOD AND BEVERAGE FORMS, WHICH HE WOULD REVIEW TO DETERMINE WHICH FORM WAS BEST SUITED FOR OUR USE.

DR. ADAIR RELATED TO THE BOARD THE URGENT NEED FOR A DOG POUND FOR CLARK COUNTY. BOARD VOTED TO GO ON RECORD APPROVING THAT -CITY-COUNTY AUTHORITIES TAKE IMMEDIATE STEPS TO PROVIDE AN ADEQUATE AND SANITARY BUILDING AND SURROUNDING AREA, FOR STRAY DOGS AND CATS.

MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING READ AND APPROVED:

DR. ADAIR READ A LETTER FROM DR. A. L. ROBY, REQUESTING THAT HIS RESIGNATION BE ACCEPTED, OR THAT HE BE GRANTED LEAVE OF ABSENCE WHILE SERVING WITH THE U. S. ARMY.

MOETION BY DR. BOWER AND CARRIED THAT DR. ROBY'S BE ALLOWED LEAVE OF ABSENCE.

DR. ADAIR READ A LETTER FROM MR. JAMES MC COY, COMMENDING THE CLARK COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT ON ITS EXCELLENT REPORT FOR 1960.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS WAS HELD FOR THE YEAR. 1962- DR. ELI GOODMAN NOMINATED DR. GEO. REGAN FOR PRESIDENT, SECONDED BY MR. BRUMMETT AND CARRIED. DR. GOODMAN ALSO NOMINATED DR. L. D. BOWER FOR VICE-PRES. SECONDED BY MR. BRUMMETT AND CARRIED.

DR. ADAIR BRIEFED THE BOARD ON THE ISSUING OF SEPTIC TANK PERMITS FOR THE LAST THREE MONTHS, AND INFORMED THEM THAT TO DATE-83 PERMITS HAD BEEN ISSUED, REVENUE AMOUNTING TO \$415.00.

A DISCUSSION WAS HELD REGARDING AN EXTRA WEEK'S VACATION FOR HEALTH DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES. THIS TO BE INVESTIGATED AND REPORTED AT THE NEXT MEETING.

THE MATTER OF HEPATITIS IN CLARK COUNTY WAS DISCUSSED, AND WHEN INFORMATION IS REQUESTED AS TO "WHAT TO DO", INQUIRING PERSONS ARE TOLD TO SEE THEIR FAMILY DOCTORS. (FOOD HANDLERS TO BE OVERLY CAUTIOUS) ABOUT RETURNING TO WORK TOO SOON.

THE BOARD REQUESTED THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO GIVE NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC REGARDING "FLU SHOTS" AND TO TRY TO DISPELL THE PRESENT FEAR, DUE TO A RECENT DEATH IN THE COMMUNITY, WHICH WAS DUE TO AN ALLERGY AND SHOULD IN NO WAY PREVENT PERSONS IN CLARK COUNTY FROM GETTING THEIR IMMUNIZATIONS.
