The Department is proud to announce their new mosquito control program of Summer 2023.

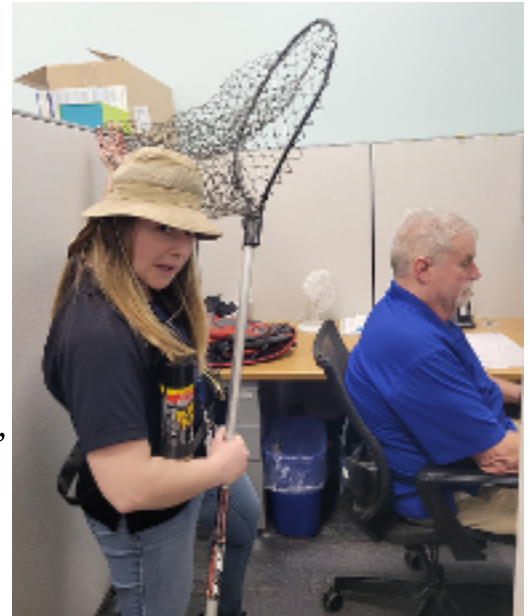
We plan to utilize advanced technology netting with a spray application to control mosquitoes in Clark County. (We still need to work on our training and mosquito identification).

COLLABORATION AT ITS BEST

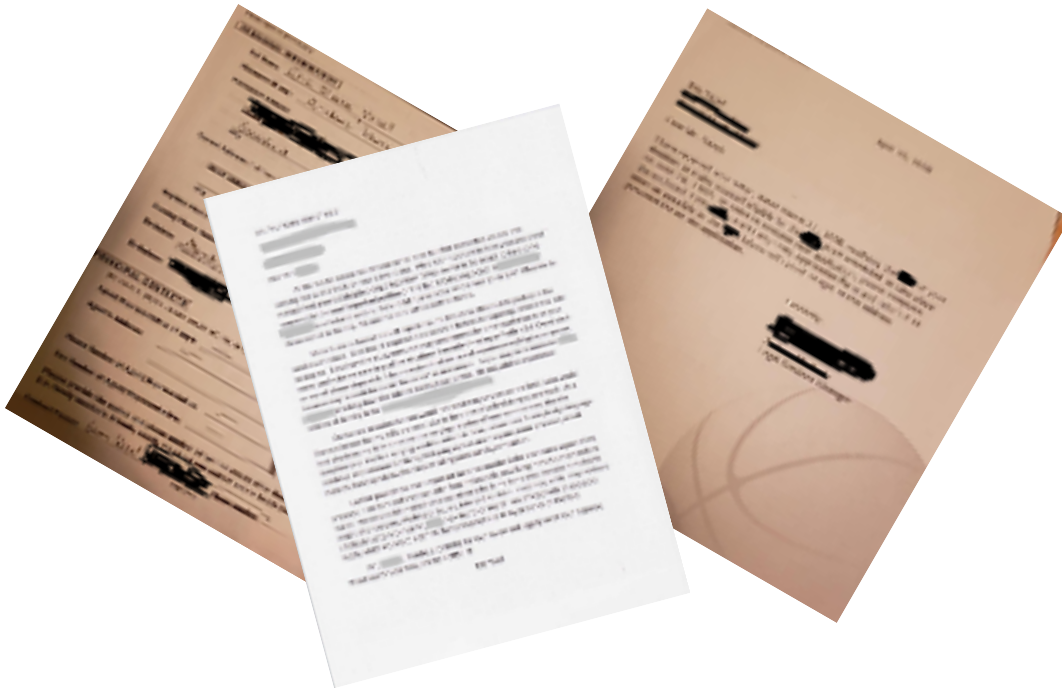
The department works closely with area first responders. Coordination between responders and the department is important for public health and safety. Groups often attend training together and a mutual respect is understood between them.

REJECTION LEADS TO REINVENTION

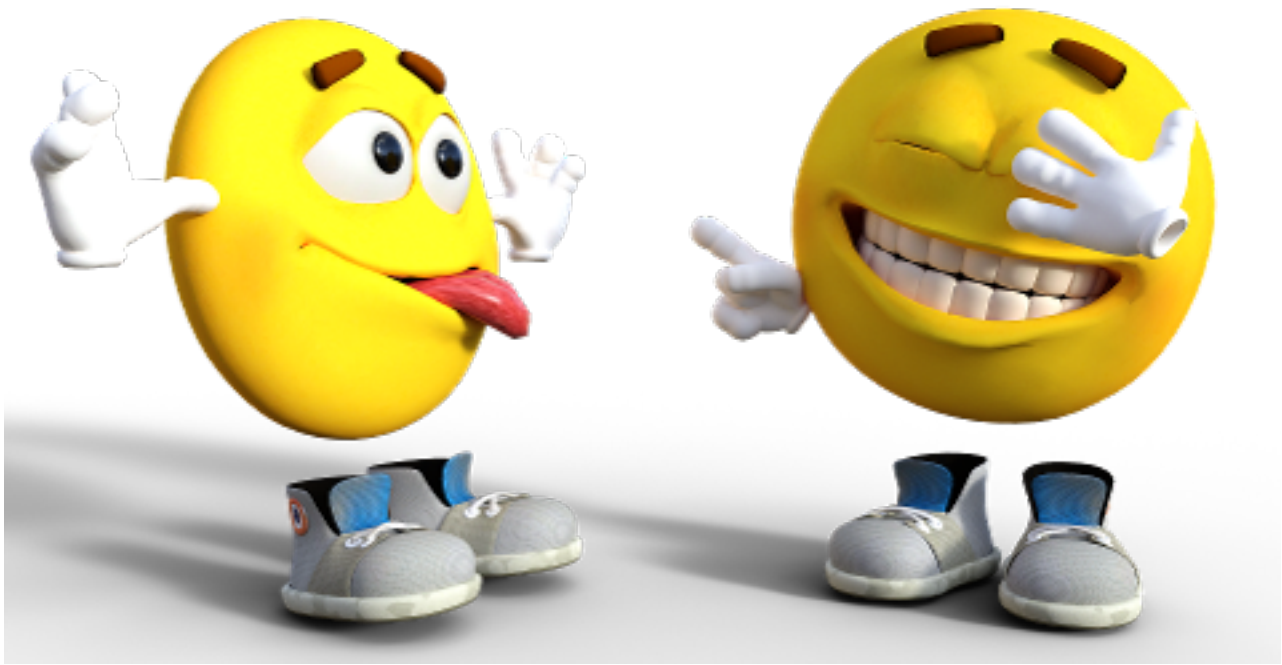
Upon hearing the news of rejection, Dr. Yazel's life is turning to a new avenue of creative expression and athletic pursuit.
